We are honored to have President Grand Master Chang Soo Lee and Secretary General Grand Master Jae Hwan Lee at our gym to instruct this year's hapkido seminar. You may have seen Grand Master Chang Soo Lee in many videos posted on YouTube conducting seminars in many countries around the world. Grand Master Chang Soo Lee and Grand Master Jae Kwan Lee are travelling from South Korean especially for this occasion. As many know, Hapkido is a Korean martial art focusing on self-defense which many Taekwondo schools include in their curriculum. This seminar will teach basic and advanced techniques such as kicks, falls, hand-to-hand combat, joint locks, breathing techniques, etc. This is a great opportunity to learn from a world-class instructor.

Along with new skills and knowledge you will obtain the tools for reshaping your school's self-defense curriculum. This may enable you to enhance student retention and enhance the overall quality of your school to better serve your students and compete in the ever-increasing competitive field of martial arts. Each attendee will receive an official certificate of participation from the **World Hapkido Union**.

If you wish to test for a Hapkido black belt, there will be an optional Black Belt Testing for a fee after the seminar. To test you must: currently hold a Taekwondo Black Belt and attend at least 2 seminar days. The testing includes official certificates from the U.S. Central Hapkido Association, the World Hapkido Union, and/or International Hapkido Federation. For those who have a Hapkido dan certification with another organization who wish to become part of WHU, IHF, or USCHA may apply to obtain an equal dan rank certification. If interested, call to obtain testing registration information. Anyone who currently holds a certification may test for promotion.

The seminar is scheduled for the weekend to accommodate your schedule. You may choose to register for any one or more of the six days. Prices are as follows: \$85 for 1 day, \$145 for 2 days, and \$185 for all sessions. The day and times of the seminar are listed below. Fridays are included at no charge for participants.
